Co-operative Childcare

Helping the Midcounties Co-operative take even better care of the children in their nurseries.



The Background

The Co-operative Childcare is part of The Midcounties Co-operative (MCC) the second largest independent Co-operative in the UK. MCC trades in a number of business sectors including Food Retail, Travel, Energy, Funeral, Childcare, Flexible Benefits, Healthcare and Post Offices and runs its business in accordance with the values and principles that are common to Co-operative's throughout the world. The Co-operative Childcare has grown from having 6 nurseries in 2004 to 46 today. The organisation is focused on providing communities with quality early years childcare and education. Trust Systems have worked with The Co-operative Childcare team to roll out a scalable, secure WiFi solution enabling them to transform the way they monitor and assess the children across their nurseries.

The Challenge

Holly Sawyers, Business Transformation Manager explains, 'As part of our transformation project we were rolling out a new Childcare Assessment Application called iConnect. The application enables MCC Childcare practitioners to monitor and assess the children in their nurseries via tablets. To enable the roll-out of this vital business application we required an enterprise scalable WiFi network. This is when we began talking to Trust Systems.'

Why Trust?

'As you can imagine safe guarding the children is of the upmost importance in everything we do and we required a system where we could be confident that the technology ensured any data we collected was secure. The Trust Systems team clearly demonstrated that they not only had the technology to deliver this level of security, but they also had a solution offering to proactively monitor the environment remotely offering on-site fixes and remote support via the service desk. Having this level of support was a critical factor in our selection as we need to ensure business continuity in the work we do.'



What are the Main Functions Supported by the New System?

Tom Stone, Technical Director at Trust Systems explains the technology; 'The solution is a cloud-managed WiFi network delivered by Aerohive technology which enables The Co-operative Childcare nurseries to connect their tablets to the internet. The tablets are configured and managed on our TrustCloud Mobile Device Management (MDM) platform which locks the devices down and ensures that the data collected on the children is safe and secure. What this means is that no data including photos are saved to the device, all information is passed to the cloud. If a device goes missing or is stolen it can be locked down remotely and it becomes a useless piece of tin.' 'We rolled out the project within 3 months, from the start of site surveys to deployment. To date we have deployed in excess of 500 tablets, 189 Internal Access Points, 46 External Access Points and 46 Switches across the 46 sites.'

The Benefits
